- Suggested Donation \$30/case of 24

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Recipients must be age 60+ (or the spouse of a person 60+); unable to shop for and/or prepare a full meal; and at risk for malnutrition

#### **COST:**

Meals are provided "by-donation" and clients pay what they can. Donations are needed to keep the program running.

#### **Suggested Donations:**

\$6/hot meal \$5/frozen meal \$30/case of liquid nutritional supplements
