

2026 Senior Farmer's Market Produce Debit Cards are Coming!

The Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) provides low-income seniors a free benefit to help access fresh, nutritious, unprocessed locally grown fruits, vegetables, and herbs from participating farmers markets. It is a "Win-Win" program, which benefits both low-income seniors and our local farmers! Local farmers sell more produce and seniors who otherwise could not afford it are able to purchase organic, fresh fruits and vegetables as excellent supplementation to a healthy diet.

Each eligible low-income senior will need to fill out a 2026 Application/Affidavit to receive a 2026 SFMNP debit card worth \$80 to purchase fresh produce at authorized farmers markets. 2025 Debit Cards will not be valid.

After we receive your completed 2026 SFMNP application, we will mail you a 2026 SFMNP debit card from early to mid-June, depending on when we receive your application: earlier is better. If we receive your application before May 11th, you can use your card at approved markets beginning June 1st. If we receive your application after May 11th, we will be processing and sending out mid-June to early July. **We will be mailing out your card once we have all the necessary information and the card has been activated by the state.**

Who Is Eligible? Need to meet all three criteria:

- 1. Island County resident**
- 2. Age:** 60+ for non-Native Americans, 55+ for Native Americans
- 3. Income:** Up to \$2,461/ month for 1 person
Up to \$3,337/month for 2 people
For larger households, add \$876/monthly income for each additional person.

Debit cards are good through the end of October, depending on the Farmer's Market seasonal time frame. Debit Cards and Funds are limited so please call soon. **A list of participating authorized farmers markets and farm stores will be posted on our website (late May), and a list will accompany distribution of debit cards.**

When is my card active?

Cards can be used June 1st through October 31, 2026 at all participating farmer's markets. Start dates depend on the date of your application. Cards that are activated before June 1 cannot be redeemed until June 1.

- Applications received by May 22, will be active on May 29.
- Applications received by June 2, will be active on June 5.
- Applications received by June 12, will be active on June 18.
- Applications received after June 12, will be active in 5-7 days.

This activation schedule runs throughout the season until we are out of cards.
